Poronavirus Impact

The CARE Clinic felt the first impact of the coronavirus pandemic on March 17 when we closed our dental clinics, Womack suspended their Family Medicine Residents staffing of our Tuesday evening clinics, and the Veterans Administration Hospital suspended their 2nd and 4th Wednesday staffing of our evening dental clinic. On Monday, March 30, The CARE Clinic also temporarily closed all medical and specialty clinics as a precautionary measure to protect our patients, volunteers and staff. We continued to refill prescriptions for our established patients and were blessed to have several volunteer pharmacists and pharmacy technicians offer to come in and help us with this.

We would like to take this opportunity to recognize our outstanding Volunteer Directors who have been a



constant source of information and guidance as we figured out our response to this pandemic. Dr. Rich Chupkowski, Volunteer Dental Director, educated our staff about the high risk to dental professionals and how the Personal Protective Equipment we normally provide in our dental clinic is not protection against this virus. He also contacted several dental practices about seeing emergency patients for us so we have somewhere to refer a patient who is in dental pain. Dr. Kate Kelly, our Volunteer Medical Director, shared her own office's screening and treatment procedures and helped us make the difficult decision to close our medical clinics for the month of April. She is continuing to come in to review charts of the patients who have appointments each week so she can order needed medication refills. We are doing this week by week because of the high number of prescriptions to be filled, to make sure we have enough medicine in stock, and so that patients will hopefully be spread out so that

only one patient at a time comes in to pick up their prescription. Dr. Ed Jackson, our Volunteer Pharmacy Director, is coming in to check the prescriptions before we call the patients to come pick them up. Minimal staff will be available during normal daytime hours to answer phones and for patients to come in to pick up their medicine. We sincerely appreciate the leadership and dedication of our Volunteer Clinical Directors and all the health professional volunteers who have offered to help us make sure our patients are being taken care of during this difficult time.



COVID-19 is having a huge impact on our community, nation and world. In accordance with CDC guidelines, we have rescheduled the 2020 Toast of the Town to June 4 from 6 to 10 p.m. at The Cape Fear Botanical Garden. We are hopeful that this pandemic will cease and all restrictions will be lifted. # Dental Partnership Assists Community

St. Joseph of the Pines, a Life Plan Community in Southern Pines, offers retirement housing, health care and community-based services. In 2012, they began an Outreach Free Mobile Program for adults (18 yrs. or older) that need help with dental and eye screening care. The mobile unit serves residents of Moore, Cumberland and Robeson Counties. For the past four years, they have been coming to Cumberland County once a month offering emergency dental treatment such as extractions and fillings for adults who are in pain. Because they offer services that we don't offer, The CARE Clinic has been working with them, advertising their clinics and referring patients to them since they started coming to Fayetteville. When we learned they were no longer able to use the site they had been using, our Board approved their use of The CARE Clinic parking lot. Their first clinic at our site was held on February 21st and 22nd, with more clinics planned in the coming months. Dr. Sassan Bassiri, a CARE Clinic volunteer, was the volunteer dentist on both days, performing 45 dental extractions. "We thank The Care Clinic for letting us park our mobile unit at their facility" said Marlena Booth, Community Relations Liaison at St. Joseph of the Pines.

# We're Going Digital!

Thanks to a very generous grant from the Florence Rogers Charitable Trust, The CARE Clinic is converting our dental imaging system from film to digital x-rays, which is the current standard in dental practices. This has become more of a need than a want because many of our younger, more recently trained dental assistants don't know how to develop film x-rays. Besides updating to the newest technology our volunteers expect, digital x-rays have many advantages over traditional (film) x-rays including:

- Immediate viewing of the image
- Storage on the cloud, allowing easy sharing for referrals if needed
- Less radiation exposure for the patient
- Time spent developing film is eliminated, making patient appointments go faster saving time for the patient and the dental volunteers
- Examination of the tooth by the dentist is improved by being able to digitally enhance the image on the computer screen
- No processing chemicals (developer and fixer) or film are needed reducing expenses of at least \$600 per year and creating a more environmentally friendly office

The CARE Clinic took 442 dental x-rays in 2019. Thanks to the Florence Rogers Charitable Trust, our new digital x-ray system will speed up the entire process making a better experience for our patients and our dental volunteers who are coming to staff our evening clinics after working a full day in their offices. We sincerely appreciate the Trust's continuing partnership and support of our mission.

The CARE Clinic Provides Meeded Medications

Monique had lived in Florida for more than 25 years working at numerous temp jobs. Her job assignments were never consistent enough for her to obtain any health insurance. When she started having severe headaches, she visited a clinic in central Florida and was diagnosed with diabetes. In June 2019, she moved to Fayetteville to assist her sister. She started working in Fayetteville but her employer did not offer insurance. In September she needed to continue her medication but had to find it at an affordable price. Monique researched the area and found The CARE Clinic where she would be able to get her medication for free. She called the Clinic and was seen within a few days. Monique is so grateful for The CARE Clinic. "The doctors, staff, and volunteers commit their personal time and resources to care for people. They get nothing out of it but the satisfaction of knowing they were able to help another human being face another day with a little more comfort than before. I have come to know and love a few of the volunteers and pray God's richest and best for their sacrifice" said Monique.

Five Host Homes developed a menu and prepared their own food and three Host Homes choose to go out to dinner. In addition, six Host families joined together to host a dinner open to the public at Highland Country Club where 157 guests enjoyed heavy hors doeuvres, a raffle and music from 80's Unplugged. Again this year, Gates Four Golf & Country Club donated the use of The March F. Riddle Room and dinner for the 56 guests who attended and enjoyed the ever-popular raffle. As you can see, flexibility abounds with this event, which allows our hosts to think of new ideas to keep their dinners interesting and exciting!

The Evening of CARE Committee did a fantastic job raising \$36,875 in sponsorship while also securing 22 host homes and 2 venues! Look to GOI

Numbers 21:4–9 (NASB): Then they set out from Mount Hor by the way of the Red Sea, to go around the land of Edom; and the people became impatient because of the journey. The people spoke against God and Moses, "Why have you brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness? For there is no food and no water, and we loathe this miserable food." The LORD sent fiery serpents among the people and they bit the people, so that many people of Israel died. So the people came to Moses and said, "We have sinned, because we have spoken against the LORD and you; intercede with the LORD, that He may remove the serpents from us." And Moses interceded for the people. Then the LORD said to Moses, "Make a fiery serpent, and set it on a standard; and it shall come about, that everyone who is bitten, when he looks at it, he will live." And Moses made a bronze serpent and set it on the standard; and it came about, that if a serpent bit any man, when he looked to the bronze serpent, he lived".

In these very strange and uncertain times, it is important to remember that God is always up to something good – even when times are tough. Like the children of Israel in the passage above, they were forced to do some soul-searching. God used the situation to check the hearts and minds of the people.

The Scripture says in Hebrews 4:12 (NASB) "For the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart".

In this time of "forced sabbath", it is good to take stock of all the things we treasure as important and the things we take for granted. We live in a day when, by-and-large, people fail to stop and recognize the Creator and give Him thanks for His unfailing love. As we "reset" as a nation and the world, let's remember to look to the Son of Man that was raised up on the cross to deliver us from disconnection with God.
