## NEW CLINIC DEDICATED



The transition to our new clinic is complete! Gone is the stereotypical “free clinic” with peeling paint and a leaky roof. Our new home is a beautiful custom-built facility that provides our patients and volunteers with a clinic that more accurately reflects the high quality of care that is given and received here. The larger building offers additional features not available in the old clinic including a private room for the chiropractic clinic, a small conference room for nutrition or stop smoking classes, a locked medical records room, and a room for sterilizing dental instruments.

The move to the new clinic took place the week of October 15th. Local non-profits were given an opportunity to claim items left behind, such as furniture or cabinets, then the old clinic was torn down and the parking lot was paved. The dedication ceremony was held on the beautiful sunny Sunday afternoon of November 18th. Guests were entertained by the City Hall Bluegrass Band before the ceremony. The Executive Director, Cathy Ory, briefly reviewed the history of The CARE Clinic and explained how the new clinic started out as a project to replace a leaky roof on the old clinic. Board President, Carol Danielson, presented surprised staff members with gifts of appreciation from the Board. She then recognized our construction partners who are listed in a separate article in this newsletter.

The highlight of the ceremony was a moving testimonial from one of our patients, Ms. Peggy Middleton. Having previously had insurance, Ms. Middleton found herself in an unfamiliar situation where she needed health care but she could not afford to see a doctor. She learned of our clinic at an agency fair and finally swallowed her pride and made an appointment. When the doctor asked her what was wrong all she could do was cry. She was ashamed at having to use a free clinic, but said she is always treated with such compassion and concern by the volunteers that she is able to maintain her dignity.

Members of our Congregations for CARE Committee offered special prayers for our patients, leaders and board members, volunteers, staff and construction workers and benefactors. Father Willard Rucinski completed the ceremony by blessing the building. Guests were invited inside to tour the clinic and enjoy refreshments.

## Construction Partners

The CARE Clinic was very blessed in our efforts to provide an improved facility for our patients and volunteers by receiving very generous grants, donations and discounts for our construction project. We would like to thank the following foundations for awarding the construction grants noted: The Kate B. Reynolds Charitable Trust - \$150,000; The NC Office of Rural Health and Community Care - \$75,000; Cumberland Community Foundation - \$27,500; The Cannon Foundation - \$25,000; The Wachovia Foundation - \$8,500; and Sam's Club Foundation - \$5,000. The grant from the Cumberland Community Foundation was a challenge grant which required us to raise \$82,500 from the local community. We appreciate all the individual gifts that many of you sent in to cumulatively help us meet this challenge.

Many of the companies involved with the construction assisted us in our efforts to hold costs down by discounting or donating their goods or services. We are very excited to be in our new building and greatly appreciate all our partners who contributed to completion of our new clinic. Donations for our building project are even now being accepted as we still owe about \$219,000 for the purchase of the land.

## MEDICAL DIRECTOR RECEIVES AWARD

Dr. Tinsley Rucker, Volunteer Medical Director of The CARE Clinic, received the Cumberland County Cares Award at the Cumberland County Commissioners meeting on October 15<sup>th</sup>. The award was instituted by the commissioners earlier this year to recognize volunteers in the community who contribute to a better quality of life for all of us.



Dr. Rucker is a physician in a very busy family medicine practice, yet, despite the demands on his time, he has generously donated his time and talents to The CARE Clinic for over 15 years. In 1992, Dr. Rucker began serving as an active member of the original steering committee which developed The CARE Clinic. He helped determine the mission and scope of the clinic, set up policies, and spent countless hours personally recruiting other physicians to volunteer their services at the clinic, or to accept referrals in their office at no charge.

Dr. Rucker has served as Volunteer Medical Director of The CARE Clinic since it opened. This is not an honorary title. Dr. Rucker comes into the clinic every week to “do his homework”, reviewing lab and radiology results, and reviewing and co-signing charts for patients that were seen by volunteer physician assistants and nurse practitioners. He staffs one evening clinic each month to reexamine patients other volunteer physicians have recommended for referral to specialists or for donated expensive diagnostic testing. He also serves on the Clinical Services Committee which monitors care and recommends changes to the services provided.

Congratulations to Dr. Rucker for receiving this award and a sincere thank you for all you have done to help low-income, uninsured residents in our community for the past 15 years.

## 100 Clinics of CARE

The following donors have each contributed \$1,000 to underwrite the cost of one of our Tuesday or Thursday evening clinics. Approximately 25 patients are seen during an evening clinic. During a visit to the clinic, patients are examined by a nurse and doctor, evaluated for their complaints and any other needs, provided prescriptions, and referred to other resources, if appropriate. For many, this is their only source of health care while trying to manage chronic diseases like asthma, high blood pressure, and arthritis. We thank these benefactors for their generosity to The CARE Clinic and our patients!
