SHIRLEY “OMA” DICKERHOFF’S LEGACY



Mrs. Shirley Lee Dickerhoff, beloved matriarch of the Dickerhoff family, was known as “Oma” by her large, close knit family. The proud mother of four children, grandmother to 10, and great grandmother to 2, her family was blessed to have frequent and lively family gatherings, since everyone lived in the Fayetteville area. “Oma” passed on to heaven last July and is deeply missed by all those who loved her.

The Dickerhoff family has a generous tradition of giving back to our community. Mrs. Dickerhoff’s son Dr. David Dickerhoff with Spring Lake Dental Group, and son-in-law Dr. Terry Smith and granddaughter Dr. Molly Guy from Village Family Dental are all dentists who not only volunteer at The CARE Clinic, but also see CARE Clinic patients at their offices. Daughter, Jan Smith and granddaughter, Molly Guy are Co-Chairs of the 2014 Evening of CARE Committee. In honor of Dr. David’s birthday, his wife Janice generously sponsored a dental room in memory of his mother, Shirley. The plaque at dental exam room #15 proudly states: “In loving memory of our “Oma” Shirley Dickerhoff. Beneath this tribute are the names of her precious grandchildren - Meredith, Sean, Molly, Blair, Robbie, Katie, Blake, A.J., Reese and John Loyd.

We are honored to have a room named in memory of Shirley Dickerhoff at The CARE Clinic. We were not privileged to know her during her lifetime, but admire her for instilling such a great sense of community service and generosity in her family members.

POLICE ASSISTANCE REQUIRED

Early the morning of Good Friday, we received a phone call from LabCorp alerting us of a critical value on a patient. The patient had come in for a first time visit on Wednesday complaining of feeling tired. As part of the exam, the physician had ordered some routine lab work. Upon receiving the call from LabCorp, our Clinical Director pulled the chart and called our Medical Director who told her to contact the patient and tell her to get to the emergency department as soon as possible. We were not able to reach the patient or her emergency contact by the phone numbers she had given us. Unfortunately this happens frequently with our patients – phones are disconnected or numbers are changed without notice. Because of the life threatening situation, we had no choice but to contact the police for assistance.

The police responded quickly, found the patient at the address we gave them, and told the patient to contact us. A relative called back and told us the patient was too weak to call us back herself. She was told to take the patient to the emergency department as soon as possible, and have them call us when she arrived so we could fax the lab results to them. This was done, the patient was admitted, and is now doing well.

We sincerely appreciate the cooperation of our community partners, LabCorp, our Volunteer Medical Director, and the Fayetteville Police Department in helping to get this patient the care she needed. In this case they all really helped save the life of this patient.

20TH ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION 5K RUN/WALK



The skies were dark and the gathering clouds allowed sprinkles of rain, but it didn't dampen the spirit of the 120+ participants in The CARE Clinic 5K Run/1 Mile Walk, held Saturday, March 23rd. The run/walk was hosted by Southern Regional Area Health Education Center in honor of The CARE Clinic's 20th anniversary.

The Run/Walk began on the Glendale Acres neighborhood side of Southern Regional AHEC so runners/walkers could get their morning exercise in a safe environment. Participants were offered fruit, coffee and water to get energized before their run. The City of Fayetteville provided police officers to ride the winding route with the runners/walkers. The route concluded at Glendale Acres Elementary School on Skycrest Drive, where participants were treated to lunch from

Jersey Mike's. The Fayetteville Elk's Lodge #1081 donated soft drinks and Fayetteville PWC provided water for the event. Great Harvest Bread Co., Panera Bread and Fayetteville Hyperbarics, LLC donated door prizes.

Students from Methodist University and the Westover Health Academy served as volunteers for the Run/Walk. They set up tables and chairs and tied yellow balloons onto tents and banners. They guided drivers to their parking spaces, passed out registration packets and route slips, served breakfast and lunch, and manned the water station. Some even stayed to help clean up when the event concluded around noon. A special thank you goes to Donna Vann, principal of Glendale Acres Elementary School, who opened her school and also offered the school grounds for the event.

The \$20 entry fee paid by the participants included a T-shirt with the 20th anniversary logo of The CARE Clinic, and the good feeling of helping uninsured adults in the community receive the health care they need. "Feeling good after a great walk; thank you CARE Clinic" a response from one of the participants on The CARE Clinic FACEBOOK page, summed up the experience for everyone.

The generosity of the participants helped to raise almost \$2,000 for The CARE Clinic. Special thanks to our Board President, Karen Mantzouris, for coordinating this event.

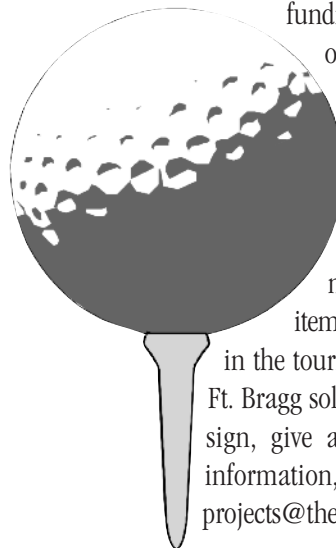

MISSION FAYETTEVILLE

Charity begins at home! The CARE Clinic encourages local churches to adopt The CARE Clinic as their medical mission work. Staffing a clinic requires 2 providers, 2 dentists, 4 nurses, 4 dental assistants, a pharmacist and two receptionists. However, if your congregation cannot provide all of these positions, the clinic will supplement them with other volunteers. Clinics are held on Tuesday, Thursday and the 2nd and 4th Wednesday. We open the doors for our patients at 4 p.m. and are usually finished by 8:30 p.m. Dinner is provided for the volunteers by local church groups.

Fayetteville Church and Westminster Presbyterian Church have been

serving as a church community at The CARE Clinic for several years.

This is a wonderful opportunity to form lasting bonds with other people from your congregation while serving low income, uninsured adults in our own community who cannot afford health insurance. Go on a mini-mission trip right at home. You will get the same feeling of satisfaction without having to leave the country. Our whole community will be better for it.
