Finding People Care

Paula was married for twenty four years. She lived in a very abusive relationship that eventually led to her having a back fusion. Paula's mother had passed away at the age of 66 because of complications with a kidney infection. With no insurance, she could not see a doctor for the medication she needed. Paula also knew that she had high cholesterol as her mother did, so she continued to stay in the marriage to keep her health insurance. Eventually, she left for fear of her life. In 2016, she was having terrible pain with a tooth and her gum. She went to the Health Department and they told her to call The CARE Clinic. When she came to have her tooth pulled, she asked what other services we provided and was thrilled to learn we could help her with her cholesterol. She started coming to The CARE Clinic regularly and at one appointment the doctor asked how she was doing. She told him that her toe was hurting and he saw that she had an ingrown toenail. We made her an appointment at Carolina Foot Care and Paula said, "They treated me just as if I had insurance and they were getting paid. They took care of everything for me. My gratefulness is more than anyone can understand. My mom is gone and I don't want to pass away anytime soon. You guys have saved me."
