“While reading the local news last June, a headline grasped my attention. The article read: Cumberland County Adult Health and Dental Clinics Discontinued Under 2018 Budget. As I delved into the article, I became greatly concerned by the abrupt discontinuation of basic care for local residents.

After reading, I felt an obligation to take action. I discovered The CARE Clinic, a local non-profit organization providing free basic medical care and dental extractions to uninsured adults. After meeting with Gloria Williams, the Special Projects Coordinator at The CARE Clinic, I realized the necessity of community donations in keeping the clinic’s doors open. Being a member of Hay Street United Methodist Church, I had access to a gym, and created a vision for an annual three-on-three basketball tournament fundraiser. After months of writing, making phone calls, and meeting with potential donors, the “Compete for CARE” tournament became a reality on September 16, 2017. With donations from thirty-seven generous community members and the participation of nine basketball teams, over \$3,780 was raised to support the life-changing work of The CARE Clinic.”

WE ARE THE CARE CLINIC

Dr. Brandt Wood, an OBGYN at Fayetteville Woman's Care, has lived all over the United States. While living in Texas, he had his first kiss and fell in love in the first grade. After graduating from Woodstown High School in 1986, he attended the University of Tennessee. In 1992, he and his elementary school sweetheart, Julie were married. He received his medical degree from Des Moines Medical University in 1997 and completed his internship and residency at Christiana Care Hospital in Newark, Delaware in 2002. He and his family moved to Fayetteville in 2004 where he joined the staff at Fayetteville Woman's Care. Years later as a member of Crossroads Church, he started a Medical Mission Team that traveled to Dominica and Romania. Dr. Wood felt the urge to volunteer his time and talents in his community and started bringing his group to The CARE Clinic. "I began volunteering as a way to give back to those in need, to do God's mission here on earth" Wood said.



PATIENT COMMENTS

Kimberly is originally from Ohio but has been in the Fayetteville area for more than 30 years. She has been a server in the past and was not offered insurance. With the lack of dental insurance, she began having issues with her teeth. She loves people and used to smile a lot but doesn't now because of her dental issues. She feels very insecure and doesn't want to go to work to be around people. She tried to get into the Missions of Mercy FREE dental clinic last year and left before she could be seen. She began having terrible tooth pain and a friend told her about The CARE Clinic. We were able to pull the tooth and she said it felt better immediately. "This place is awesome! You are very welcoming and have been very wonderful to me," Kimberly said.

Angela moved to Fayetteville in 2014. She was living in an apartment complex when Hurricane Matthew hit our area. Her apartment was flooded. Shortly thereafter, black mold began growing in the apartment. She began having health issues and sent her children to live out of state while she can establish new residency. Having no insurance, she said, "The CARE Clinic is the only place to see me. I just want to say Thank You to The CARE Clinic for everything

Once we reach the stage of emotional collapse it becomes much more complicated than taking a day off, or even a short sabbatical. It affects us physically, emotionally and spiritually. People of all walks of life and in all types of employment can experience burnout but the rate is very high in Ministry fields, Teachers, First Responders, Military and Medical workers. Pastors face tremendous stress with high expectations that are unrealistic. Teachers deal with high numbers of students that are at various ages of development and mental stability. Medical workers deal with sickness and death at all levels. First Responders hear a call and never know what they will face on arrival.
