Our CARE Clinic family was saddened by the loss of our dear friend, loyal supporter, and enthusiastic volunteer, Caroline Harsant Whitley on September 26th. Caroline joined our Community Relations Committee in 2005 while working as a business banker. Her youthful exuberance brought a refreshing new perspective to the committee's mission. She quickly impressed everyone with her professionalism and self-confidence and was elected as a member of our Board in 2006. She served as Chair of the Community Relations Committee for two years, before being elected as Secretary of the Board, a position she voluntarily held for the third time this year.

Caroline has been an inspiration to all of us in how she continued to live life to the fullest, while waging a courageous battle against cancer. Surgery and prolonged treatments only sidelined her temporarily. Caroline continued to be an active and involved volunteer, attending meetings and events whenever possible.

When The Fayetteville Observer named Caroline as one of our community's "Top 20 Under 40" in 2006, Caroline stated "I am a native of Fayetteville. I came back here because I want to make an impact on this community." Caroline definitely achieved her goal. The CARE Clinic is a better organization because of Caroline's passion and enthusiasm for our mission. She was a valued member of our CARE Clinic family and will truly be missed.

Abner has lived in Fayetteville all his life. Though he works full time in the construction industry, he does not have insurance. When he has needed health care services in the past, he always did without because he did not have the money to pay for his care. Recently he was suffering from a severe toothache and needed help. 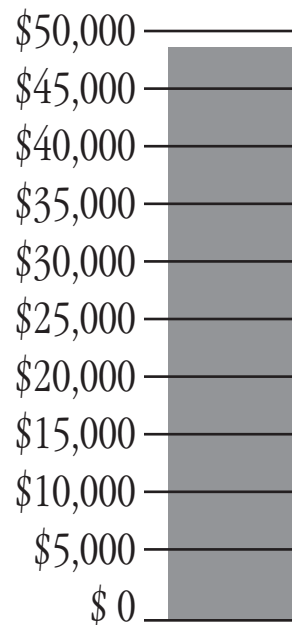

Another Need for Talented People

The CARE Clinic needs more volunteer health professionals including physicians, physician assistants, nurse practitioners, pharmacists, pharmacy technicians, nurses, dentists and dental assistants. Except for a very small paid staff, our clinics are run entirely by volunteers. Cost of Patient Care

Since we first opened in 1993, donors have often expressed an interest in covering the cost of a patient's care. As a guideline for such donations we have always included information about the average cost of a patient encounter on our reimbursement envelopes and with the statistics on our newsletters. We have been reporting this cost at \$70 per patient encounter since 2008. Costs continue to rise. With medical care this is especially true for the cost of prescription medications. Recently our Development Committee decided it was time to review our expenses and recalculated the average cost per patient visit to be \$75 – including lab work and prescription medications.

For comparison, we surveyed some local practices to find out what it would cost a patient to receive care for some of the most common services we provide here. Asthma is a common diagnosis, and an expensive one. An office visit for asthma costs an average of \$86, and medications for one month cost an additional \$285.96 for a total of \$371.96. Hypertension (high blood pressure) is another common diagnosis. Although medications are not expensive, a new patient would be charged \$123 for the office visit and \$126 for lab work. With medications for one month the total cost for the visit would be \$250.62. Follow up visits for this patient would cost \$90.50.

No matter what diagnosis you look at, The CARE Clinic continues to hold our costs way below community averages thanks to our wonderful health care professional volunteers and donated diagnostic services. As one of our supporting partners, you can be assured your donation is having the maximum impact possible in providing quality care to patients who would otherwise be unable to get the health care services they need to get well and to remain productive members of our community.

Named Gift Opportunities

The CARE Clinic's Named Gift Program has proven to be a very well-accepted way for generous donors to establish a permanent tribute, in memory or in honor of someone special while providing much needed support for our mission. Looking at the names on the room plaques as you walk through our halls brings back memories of long lost friends who were so instrumental in the start of our clinic, as well as fond feelings for our newest friends and "family" members.

We are blessed to only have a few named gift opportunities left. The Chiropractor/Procedure Room, Dental X-Ray Room, and two Dental Exam Rooms are available for \$10,000 each. A Memorial Garden will be developed to the left of our building for \$50,000. The donor will be invited to participate in the design of that area.
