Golf Has Returned For The First Time Since 2022!

On Friday June 27th, Gates Four Golf and Country Club graciously hosted The CARE Clinic's 29th Annual Charity Golf Tournament. This year's 4-Person Captain's Choice format scramble yielded 70 golfers across 18 teams; one of those being a Sponsored Soldier team! Our Event Sponsor, Cumulus Media, really helped spread the word about golf making a comeback as they aired a 30 second ad across their 4 stations for weeks leading up to the big day!

At registration, golfers were fueled by Caribou Coffee and chicken biscuits from Chick-fil-A. Tee time was 9:30am and the summer sun was already blazing. Golfers remained refreshed with sodas and Gatorade that were provided by the CARE Clinic; beer that was donated by Healy Wholesale; and water that was donated by PWC. Our Diamond sponsor, Tropical Smoothie Cafe, came through huge when they dropped off 100 smoothies around noon. Our Director of Development and Marketing, Nicole Ryan, drove around with two of the CARE Clinic's current interns from FSU, and distributed all of the smoothies to golfers along the course. Royal Soleil Marketing and Photography donated their time and hopped in a golf cart to capture shots of all of the golfers for the entire day. While no one hit a hole in one, there were still many winners!

The H8TERS Golf team came in first place and snagged 4 rounds of golf donated by Gates Four Golf & Country Club. One of our Event Sponsor's teams, Cumulus Media, took home second place and a Field Box with 12 tickets and 4 baseball caps for a Fayetteville Woodpeckers game. The third-place team was from one of our Gold Sponsors, Curi Insurance, and they took home (4) \$50 gift cards to Luigi's Italian Chophouse. Our Longest Drive winner was Alex Keith, and he took home a gift bag from Bubba's 33. Billy Page won the Closest to the Pin contest and took home a gift basket from Texas Roadhouse. And this year's 50/50 Raffle winner of \$277.50 was Sean Farrelly! Each golf team had their own two golf carts with bags from Elevate Real Estate containing: cooling towels; discount cards from Texas Roadhouse or Bubba's 33; pens from Cumulus Media and Edward Jones Investment; free Luigi's Chophouse appetizer cards; and a family pass from Main Event (1 hour of free bowling for 5 people w/ shoe rental, 4 games of laser tag, and 4 1-hour cards for arcade games). We also had two amazing vendors set up to share their services: Dave Woodcox of the Redwolf Tobacconist; and Quancidine Hinson-Gribble.

Overall, this year's tournament ran very smoothly and paved the way for our 30th annual event next year! We are immensely thankful for all that registered to play, as well as those that generously donated their time to volunteer (including our office staff members) with registration, beverage carts, being contest witnesses, and at various other stations. Without each of them, this event would not have been the same! Lastly, another gratitude-filled thank you to all sponsors who helped make the return of golf such a success. It was not only a fun day, but one that will allow The CARE Clinic to continue to provide the vital medical and dental services that so many in our community need. After major expenses, we raised over \$10,500; and if we consider the valuation of our in-kind Event Sponsorship, along with food and drink donated, the full value raised is over \$16,600!

Beacon of Hope

As recent immigrants my brother and I both can't express enough gratitude to the CARE Clinic. Their compassionate team understood the unique challenges that my brother and I both faced, offering not just medical care but genuine support. Their incredible team has been a lifeline during our challenging transition. From the moment we walked in we were greeted by warm, friendly staff who made us feel comfortable instantly. The bilingual staff made us feel heard and respected, breaking down communication barriers effortlessly.

We both came to the Clinic not feeling our best, and we ended up not only finding out that we were overweight, but that we had become diabetic. The nutritionist we saw for a few months helped to teach us how to eat better and maintain a healthier lifestyle. The diabetic clinic helped maintain our diabetes until we no longer needed medication.

We are so impressed with how quickly we were seen, and without financial stress (their free services are a blessing for those struggling to navigate healthcare); but what truly sets them apart is their genuine commitment to the community. By providing reliable, free medical services with unparalleled kindness and efficiency, the CARE Clinic is a beacon of hope for the community and for immigrants like us.



The Lung Bus

On June 11th, 2025, The CARE Clinic was fortunate to link up with FirstHealth of the Carolinas for a one-day event in which they brought their Lung Bus to the Clinic. The Lung Bus is a mobile imaging system that offers low-dose CT lung screening technology for those in communities in the Sandhills region. Offering imaging services outside the hospital helps reach individuals who may not have access or the opportunity to get this scan otherwise. This amazing service is also done free of charge to those eligible.

CT scans remain the gold standard for helping providers identify lung cancer at its earliest stages when there is a better chance for cure. An estimated 238,340 people were diagnosed with lung cancer in 2023 in the United States, and it is the leading cause of cancer deaths in North Carolina. About 90% of stage 1 cancers are completely treatable, so early screening is essential. The Lung Bus is equipped with a 40-slice CT scanner and scans are performed by a certified technologist. The test is simple and quick, taking only about 10 minutes. Preregistration and screening were suggested, but walk-ups were also permitted.

Eligibility criteria must be met in order to qualify to be scanned. Call (910) 715-LUNG (5864) for more information. The next date that the Lung Bus will be at The CARE Clinic is Wednesday August 27th!




